St Matthew's C of E Primary School has existed on its present site since the last 1850s, almost as long as the church itself. Much of the fundraising for the school was organised by the first vicar of St Matthew's, Fr Richard Malone. The Church and the School now share the same logo but St Matthew's PCC is keen to strengthen the relationship further between our congregation and our Church school.

The school now has a nice room for the library but needs some new, up to date books on a wide range of subjects including science, geography, history, religious education, biographies of famous people and bi-lingual dictionaries e.g. Latin, to supplement the existing book stock and to improve the library provision for the 21st century.

The PCC thought that this would be an ideal, worthwhile project which the church congregation may like to support to ensure that the children can have excellent resources from which to research a wide range of topics in the National Curriculum. There is still a need for books as the internet is not necessarily ideal for all subjects and all children's individual learning styles!
